SUMMARY: Designates a bridge over the Frankstown Branch of the Juniata River as the Williamsburg Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designate the bridge which crosses over the Frankstown Branch of the Juniata River on State Route 2015, also known as Yellow Springs Drive, in Catharine Township and Williamsburg Borough, Blair County, as the Williamsburg Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation at each end of the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
