SUMMARY: Provides multiple designations for highways and bridges. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would make the following highway and bridge designations:

- State Route 233 from the western corporate limits of Newville Borough to State Route 11 in Cumberland County as the Marine Lance Corporal Nicholas B. Morrison Memorial Highway.
- State Route 2038 in Horsham Township, Montgomery County from Maple Avenue to Meetinghouse Road is designated as the 2LT James P. Kelly Memorial Highway.
- The bridge that carries State Route 94 over Bermudian Creek in Latimore Township, Adams County, is designated as the Sgt. Michael C. Weigand Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge over the Allegheny River on State Routes 268 and 368 in Parker, Armstrong County is designated as the Veterans Memorial Bridge.
- The interchange of Exit 6 on Interstate 70 in Claysville, Washington County is designated as the Sergeant Nathan P. Kennedy Memorial Interchange.
- The bridge in Carroll Township, Washington County on State Route 2023 over Pigeon Creek is designated as the Stanley Jurgaitis Memorial Bridge.
- The Davis Street Bridge over Interstate 81 at Exit 182, Moosic Borough, Lackawanna County is re-designated as the Andrew A. Pompey and Durando J. Pompey Memorial Bridge.
- The eastbound bridge carrying Interstate 90 over Six-Mile Creek in Harborcreek Township, Erie County is designated as the Senior Airman Bryan R. Bell Memorial Bridge.
- The Duboistown Bridge on Arch Street connecting Williamsport and Duboistown over the west branch of the Susquehanna River in Lycoming County is re-designated as the Lance Corporal Abram Howard Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge on Dillerville Road in Lancaster, Lancaster County is designated as the Captain Edward Anthony Davis Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge carrying PA Turnpike Route 43 over the Monongahela River between Denbo in Washington County and Alicia in Fayette County is designated as the PFC Ronald C. "Smokey" Bakewell Memorial Bridge.
- The bridge carrying State Route 4021 over Brubaker Run in Cambria County is designated as the Sergeant Derek Lee Shanfield Memorial Bridge.

- The bridge carrying State Route 1004 over Pennypack Creek in Philadelphia County is designated as the Paul W. Kauffman Memorial Bridge.
- Interstate 95 from Mile Marker 23 to 35 in Philadelphia County is designated as the Officers O'Hanlon and Lorenzo Memorial Highway.
- The Ewing Road Interchange on PA Route 376 in Moon Township, Allegheny County is designated as the Jack W. Wise Interchange.
- U.S. Route 62 in Venango County is designated as the Venango County Veterans Highway.
- U.S. Route 62 in Forest County is designated as the Forest County Veterans Highway.
- U.S. Route 62 in Warren County is designated as the Warren County Veterans Highway.
- State Route 30 from Church Road to Rittenhouse Place in Lower Merion Township, Montgomery County is designated as the Master Sergeant Scott Ball Memorial Avenue.
- The bridge which crosses the Juniata River on State Route 2015 in Catherine Township and Williamsburg Borough in Blair County is designated as the Williamsburg Memorial Bridge.
- State Route 837, from its intersection with State Route 1065 to its intersection with State Route 1069 in Washington County is designated as the Mayor George Bugaile Memorial Highway.
- The bridge carrying State Route 896 over Mill Creek in East Lampeter Township, Lancaster County is designated as the PFC Brandon M. Styer Memorial Bridge.
- The Uniontown to Brownsville link of PA Turnpike Route 43 in Fayette County is designated as the POW/MIA/KIA Memorial Highway.
- The bridge carrying Morris Road over the Wissahickon Creek in Montgomery County is designated as the Jack Turner Bridge.
- The Mid-County Interchange (Exit 20) on Interstate 476 in Plymouth Township, Montgomery County is designated as the Morris Gerber and A. Richard Gerber Memorial Interchange.
- The Marshalls Creek Bypass in Monroe County is designated as the Joseph W. Battisto Bypass.
- State Route 739, Pike County, from State Route 6 to the state line is designated as the Pike County Veterans' Way.
- The bridge on State Route 4002 in Snow Shoe Township, Centre County is designated as the Clarence Bridge of Freedom for All Veterans.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. There are 28 highways or bridges in this legislation, therefore the aggregate cost to PennDOT will be \$14,000. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
