SUMMARY: Designates a portion of Interstate 78 in Berks County, from mile marker 23 to mile marker 35, as the CMSgt. Richard L. Etchberger Memorial Highway. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would designate a portion of Interstate 78 in Berks County, from mile marker 23 to mile marker 35, as the CMSgt. Richard L. Etchberger Memorial Highway.

PennDOT shall be responsible for the placement and maintenance of signs displaying the designations of this bill.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost would be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
