**SUMMARY:** Amends the Mental Health and Mental Retardation Act of 1966 by renaming the law as the Mental Health and Intellectual Disability Act of 1966 and making the associated reference changes throughout the act.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation renames the existing act and replaces the terms “mental retardation” and “mentally retarded” to “intellectual disability” and “those with intellectual disabilities” as contained in the existing law.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The estimate assumes that any current printed materials would be depleted before reprinting with the new references.
