**SUMMARY:** Senate Bill 707, Printer's Number 694, amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) to extend the Educational Leave of Absence status to spouses. The act shall take in 60 days upon enactment.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill amends Section 7313 of Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes by adding spouses to the Educational Leave of Absence status for members of the Pennsylvania National Guard or other reserve component of the armed forces of the United States. Members and spouses on military leave of absence from their educational institution shall be entitled to be restored to the educational status attained before military duty without loss of credits earned, scholarships or grants awarded or tuition and other fees paid prior to the commencement of the military duty.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will not adversely impact Commonwealth funds.
