**SUMMARY:** Senate Bill 858 amends Article X of the Public School Code concerning District Superintendents and Assistant Superintendents. It would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would allow a person to be eligible for election or appointment as a district superintendent or assistant superintendent if the individual holds a graduate degree from an accredited institution of higher education in business or finance. If hired under this clause, the individual must complete a leadership development program meeting the Pennsylvania School Leadership Standards as outlined under Section 1217 of the Public School Code.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
