**SUMMARY:** Amends the Second Class Township Code regarding the purchase of insurance. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would amend the Second Class Township Code to permit the township to pay, in whole or in part, the cost of providing supplemental Medicare insurance coverage to supervisors, their dependents and township employees who are over 65 years of age.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Second class townships will realize the potential for savings by having the option to purchase supplemental Medicare insurance coverage for eligible supervisors, dependents and employees instead of higher-priced health insurance plans.
