SUMMARY: Senate Bill 1123 is the Commonwealth's non-preferred appropriation to the University of Pittsburgh for fiscal year 2012-2013. It will take effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS: This legislation appropriates a total of \$136,076,000 for The University of Pittsburgh. It specifies \$133,993,000 is for general support and \$2,083,000 is for rural education outreach. These are the same amounts that were appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will cost the Commonwealth \$136,076,000 in fiscal year 2012-2013 only.
