SUMMARY: Senate Bill 1126 is the Commonwealth's non-preferred appropriation to the University of Pennsylvania for fiscal year 2012-2013. It will take effect July 1, 2012, or immediately, whichever is later.

ANALYSIS: This legislation appropriates a total of \$28,137,000 for the University of Pennsylvania. It specifies \$27,889,000 for veterinary activities and \$248,000 for the Center for Infectious Diseases. These are the same amounts that were appropriated for fiscal year 2011-2012.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will cost the Commonwealth \$28,137,000 in fiscal year 2012-2013 only.
