SUMMARY: Amends the County Code regarding the classification of counties. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: Under this bill, after the results of any Federal Decennial Census are published, any county of the third class having a population of 500,000 inhabitants and over may elect not to become a county of the second class A, by enacting an ordinance or adopting a resolution of the board of county commissioners not later than February 15 of the year following the year in which the census figures are certified.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse impact on Commonwealth or county funds.
