**SUMMARY:** Designates a portion of State Route 3 in Chester County as the Senator Robert J. Thompson Highway; and a bridge on Pottstown Pike in Chester County as the Representative Sam Morris and Eleanor Morris Memorial Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would designate the portion of State Route 3, between U.S. Route 202 in West Goshen and Adams Street in West Chester, Chester County as the Senator Robert J. Thompson Highway.

Additionally, it designates the Pottstown Pike Bridge, between Prizer Road and Pughtown Road, over the French Creek in South Coventry Township, Chester County, as the Representative Sam Morris and Eleanor Morris Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. The \$1,000 cost in this legislation can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
