SUMMARY: Amends the law regulating police in second class cities by further providing for the residency requirement. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation would amend Act 265 of 1951, which regulates police in second class cities (Pittsburgh). This legislation would change the residency requirement by providing that a second class city may require a police officer to become a resident of the city as a condition of employment. The legislation also provides that a second class city may require a reinstated police officer to meet the same residency requirement as all other police officers.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or City of Pittsburgh funds.
