SUMMARY: Amends the Insurance Company Law of 1921 concerning the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: House Bill 108 changes the expiration date of CHIP from December 31, 2013 to December 31, 2015.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. The 2012-13 General Fund budget provides \$3,640,000 for CHIP administration, a \$101,608,000 appropriation for the program's insurance expenses, and \$35,257,000 from dedicated cigarette tax revenues, also for insurance. That budget also anticipates a similar amount will be needed to fund the program in 2013-14.
