SUMMARY: Amends the Industrialized Housing Act to clearly give the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) the power to issue regulations to create a certification program for the construction/installation of industrialized commercial buildings. This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the Industrialized Housing Act (Act 70 of 1972) to require that DCED adopt regulations to administer a certification program to regulate the construction and installation standards of industrialized commercial buildings and modules.

The legislation also amends the act to clarify that DCED may issue certification insignia to industrialized commercial buildings and modules that have been certified by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) or other competent authority.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
