SUMMARY: House Bill 129, Printer's Number 361, amends the Telemarketer Registration Act to prohibit telemarketing on legal holidays and maintain the "do-not-call" list.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends the Telemarketer Registration Act (Act 147 of 1996) to prohibit the conducting of telemarketing activities on a legal holiday. It also requires that the listing of a telephone number on the "do-not-call" list be maintained until such time as the number is no longer valid for the subscriber or the subscriber requests to have the telephone number removed from the list.

This shall take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
