SUMMARY: Amends the definition of "fire department vehicle" in Title 75 (Vehicle Code) to include vehicles owned or leased by a fire relief association and utilized by an organized paid or volunteer fire department; amends the definition of "emergency vehicle" to include state emergency management vehicles; exempts employees of the state emergency management agency from obtaining a commercial driver's license (CDL). This legislation would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends the definition of "emergency vehicle" in section 102 of Title 75 to include state emergency management vehicles. The amendment also exempts employees of the state emergency management agency who hold a Class C License and receive authorization from the head of the agency from obtaining a commercial driver's license (CDL) while they are operating an emergency vehicle registered to the Commonwealth.

This legislation expands the definition of a "fire department vehicle" to include: vehicles owned or leased by a fire relief association and utilized by an organized paid or volunteer fire department.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
