**SUMMARY:** House Bill 307, Printer's Number 545, amends the Air Pollution Control Act to exempt vehicles using natural gas from certain standards. This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill amends the Air Pollution Control Act (Act 787 of 1960) to exempt vehicles using liquefied petroleum gas or natural gas retrofit systems from the provisions of the Pennsylvania Clean Vehicles Program. The new language states that, "in addition to the exceptions to the adoption, incorporation and application by the Clean Vehicles Program of the provisions of the California Low Emission Vehicle Program, Title 13 CCR, Division 3, Chapters 1 and 2, contained under 25 Pa. Code § 126.411(b) (relating to general requirements), the provisions of Title 13 CCR, Division 3, Chapter 1, § 2030 (relating to liquefied petroleum gas or natural gas retrofit systems) shall also be excepted."

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
