SUMMARY: Amends the Second Class Township Code to permit second class townships to purchase used equipment from another governmental unit without advertising and bidding. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation permits second class townships to purchase used equipment, apparatus, appliances, vehicles or related parts from another municipality, a county, school district, municipal authority, council of government or the state or Federal government without advertising, bidding or price quotations as otherwise required by the Code.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. It is probable that this legislation will provide second class townships some savings as they could purchase used goods at a lower price, reduce advertising expenses for bidding announcements, and reduce costs preparing bidding specifications.
