SUMMARY: Amends Title 30 (Fish and Boat Code) to remove law enforcement powers from members of the Fish and Boat Commission's Board of Commissioners.

ANALYSIS: HB 681 repeals the provision in Title 30 Section 301(f) that affords Fish and Boat commissioners the same enforcement powers of a waterways conservation officer (WCO), which include, but are not limited to, subpoena, execution of warrants, search and seizure, and arrest powers.

Effective Date: 60 days.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
