**SUMMARY:** House Bill 827 amends the Crimes Code concerning retaliation against a witness, victim, or party. It would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation corrects a technical error in Section 4953 of the Crimes Code, which concerns retaliation against a witness, victim, or party. The error is found in a reference to Section 4952 of the Crimes Code, relating to intimidation of witnesses.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
