SUMMARY: Establishes time limitations on motorcycle learners' permits. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation amends Title 75 Section 1505 (relating to learners' permits) to provide that motorcycle learners' permits shall be non-renewable. The legislation would also allow a person to reapply for a motorcycle learner's permit no more than three times in a five-year period from when that person first applies.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. Additional revenue for both the Motor License Fund and the Motorcycle Safety Education Account is probable due to the fact that permit renewals would be prohibited and a new permit would be required. Estimating such cases would be indeterminable at this point.
