SUMMARY: House Bill 1141 amends the Public School Code concerning the reopening of school district annual budgets.

ANALYSIS: This legislation adds a new section to the School Code that allows a board of school directors of a school district to reopen its annual budget for a period of 30 days after the annual State general appropriation act is enacted, to reflect Federal and State allocations for the current fiscal year provided by the annual State general appropriation act.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
