SUMMARY: Designates the bridge crossing the Lackawanna River along 8th Avenue, in downtown Carbondale, Lackawanna County as the 109th Infantry Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates the bridge crossing the Lackawanna River along 8th Avenue, also known as U.S. Business Route 6, in downtown Carbondale, Lackawanna County, as the 109th Infantry Bridge.

The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge. The signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic will also bear the 109th Infantry's motto "Cives Arma Ferant: Let the Citizens Bear Arms".

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
