SUMMARY: House Bill 1325, Printer's Number 1706, amends the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act by adding definitions and providing for official plans and permits. This legislation would take effect immediately upon enactment.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends the Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act (Act 537 of 1965) by adding definitions for "community on-lot sewage system" and "individual on-lot sewage system."

The bill inserts new language stating that, for official plans and official plan revisions for individual on-lot sewage systems and community on-lot sewage systems, the use of such systems shall satisfy the antidegradation requirements of the Clean Streams Law (Act 394 of 1937). New language is also added that permits for individual on-lot sewage systems and community on-lot sewage systems shall satisfy the antidegradation requirements of the Clean Streams Law as well.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
