SUMMARY: House Bill 1460, Printer's Number 1892, amends Title 51 (Military Affairs) further providing for educational leave of absence. This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

ANALYSIS: This bill amends Title 51 (Military Affairs), specifically Section 7313 regarding the educational leave of absence to require educational institutions to place an "M" on the grade transcript of a military member or spouse for all classes that they are unable to complete due to a military leave of absence.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
