SUMMARY:

House Bill 1769, printer's number 3747, amends the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L. 90, No. 21), as reenacted and amended, and known as The Liquor Code, to further provide for responsible alcohol management. The effective date is 60 days after enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The bill amends Section 471.1 of The Liquor Code by adding a subsection to require all alcohol service personnel to complete the seller or server Responsible Alcohol Management training within sixty days of being hired by a licensed establishment unless the seller or server completed the training prior to being hired. The bill also directs the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board (PLCB) to certify private third-party providers of responsible alcohol management training that covers, at a minimum, the content contained in the Bureau of Alcohol Education's standard curriculum. The PLCB shall advise third-party providers of deficiencies in curriculum to ensure that it equivalent to the standard curriculum. Private third-party providers may modify the order in which the responsible alcohol management training curriculum is presented so long as all the material is taught.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
