SUMMARY:

House Bill 1816 amends the Public School Code concerning continuing professional development and Pennsylvania school leadership standards. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation amends the Public School Code concerning continuing professional development. It allows a local education agency's continuing professional development plan to include visits by educators to a manufacturing workplace, under which the board of directors approves the professional educator's participation in a site visit to a manufacturing location for orientation and demonstrations to give the professional educator a greater understanding of job opportunities in manufacturing for students.

In addition, HB 1816 requires that Pennsylvania school leadership standards include corollary standards addressing the creation of a culture of teaching and learning in manufacturing and vocational fields.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
