**SUMMARY:** Repeals the PA Employment Agency Law (PEAL). This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation would repeal Act 261 of 1941, known as the "Employment Agency Law", in its entirety.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** According to the Department of Labor and Industry, this legislation would save the Commonwealth about \$86,217 annually. The department registers approximately 60 employment agencies each year. In fiscal year 2012-13, the department collected \$23,760 in agency license fees, employment agent registrations and renewals. The costs to the department were approximately \$109,977, including both personnel and operating, to administer and enforce the law.
