**SUMMARY:** House Bill 2039, Printer's Number 3040, amends Act 405 of 1945, which established the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin. This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

**ANALYSIS:** The bill amends Act 405 of 1945, which established the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin to cooperate in the control and abatement of pollution of the water of the drainage basin of the Potomac River. Pennsylvania has two members on the commission appointed by the Governor: one of whom shall be a member of the public knowledgeable in matters involving water pollution and the other shall be a member of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The bill inserts language to provide that a member of the commission may have a designee with voting rights.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this bill will have no fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. The purpose of the legislation is to ensure and allow for a designee with voting rights when the appointed member cannot attend a meeting.
