SUMMARY: Senate Bill 194 amends Act 13 of 2002, known as the Medical Care and Reduction of Error (MCARE) Act. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS: This legislation repeals section 743 of the MCARE Act, concerning reports to the commissioner and claims information. This eliminates a requirement that the Pennsylvania Insurance Department submit a claims data report to the General Assembly.

FISCAL IMPACT: Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds. It will provide a minimal cost savings to the Insurance Department since the Department will no longer have to annually prepare this report, which can run to over 1,000 pages.
