SUMMARY:

Senate Bill 267 amends the Public School Code concerning excuses from attending school. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 267 amends the Public School Code section concerning excuses from attending school. It adds to the list of acceptable excuses for a student not attending school that a school district may excuse a student from school attendance to participate in an educational tour or trip not sponsored by the school district, consistent with existing State Board of Education regulations.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
