SUMMARY: Senate Bill 358, Printer's Number 1496, requires notification of breast density to patients who receive a mammogram. This legislation is effective in 90 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation, known as the Breast Density Notification Act, requires that each mammography report and any other written notification concerning the report provided to a patient include the patient's breast density information based on the Breast Imaging Reporting and Data System established by the American College of Radiology. The legislation includes standard language to be used in each notice regarding breast density.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
