SUMMARY: Designates a bridge carrying State Route 88 over the Ten Mile Creek as the Lieutenant General William M. Keys Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a bridge carrying State Route 88 over the Ten Mile Creek connecting Jefferson Township, Greene County and East Bethlehem Township, Washington County as the Lieutenant General William M. Keys Bridge.

The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
