SUMMARY: Designates a bridge to be constructed over the Amtrak rail lines in Lancaster County as the Thaddeus Stevens Bridge. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: SB 851 designates a bridge to be constructed on that portion of State Route 222 over the Amtrak rail lines in the city of Lancaster, Lancaster County, replacing the Lititz Pike Bridge, as the Thaddeus Stevens Bridge.

The Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to traffic in both directions on the bridge.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
