SUMMARY: Provides for the Highway Capital Budget Project Itemization Act of 2014-15 and itemizes additional capital projects in the category of public highway projects.

ANALYSIS: SB 1384 is the Highway Capital Budget Project Itemization Act of 2014-15. This legislation identifies various highway projects across the state to be constructed by PennDOT or its designees. Projects are funded through the Motor License Fund.

The legislation also designates funds from the federal government for the construction of the itemized projects. Any excess funds, as determined by PennDOT, may be designated to other capital projects.

Effective: Immediately

FISCAL IMPACT: The total authorization for the capital projects itemized in the category of Public Highway Projects is \$19,154,285,000. This legislation simply enables these projects for selection by the State Transportation Commission. Selected projects will be financed by the incurring of debt or from current revenues of the Motor License Fund.
