SUMMARY:

House Bill 73 amends the Judicial Code concerning the counseling of sexually violent predators. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 73 amends the Judicial Code to require that providers of counseling services to sexually violent predators notify the district attorney of the county and the chief law enforcement officer of the municipality in the county and municipality where the provider is located that the provider is counseling sexually violent predators. If there is no local police force the provider must notify the Pennsylvania State Police. These notifications must be submitted in writing by January 15 of each year and must include the address of the provider.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
