SUMMARY:

House Bill 89 amends the Judicial Code concerning the mandatory retirement age for judges.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation increases the mandatory retirement age for judges and magisterial district judges from 70 to 75 years in the Judicial Code. This bill only becomes effective if a proposed constitutional amendment to raise the mandatory retirement age for judges is approved in two consecutive legislative sessions and adopted by the voters. Such an amendment was approved in the 2013-14 legislative session, but must still be approved in the current session and adopted by the voters.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no quantifiable impact on Commonwealth funds.
