SUMMARY:

House Bill 158 amends the School Code concerning the declaration of weather emergencies. It would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS:

House Bill 158 adds a new section to the School Code giving the Secretary of Education the power to declare a weather emergency on a school entity, charter school entity, county, or statewide basis. This would provide the school entities or charter school entities included in the declaration greater flexibility in scheduling to meet the 180 instructional day requirement without jeopardizing any of their payments or reimbursements from the state.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
