SUMMARY: Makes specific designations in Washington and Westmoreland Counties. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes the following designations:

1. the interchange of S.R. 43 in Washington County at the Mon-Fayette Expressway Interchange with S.R. 88, known as Exit 28, as the Marine Cpl. Thomas R. Matty Memorial Interchange.
2. the bridge on that portion of S.R. 1013, known as Knupp Road, over Hypocrite Creek, Fairfield Township, Westmoreland County, as the PFC LeRoy D. "Whitey" Schaller Bridge.
3. a portion of S.R. 711 in New Florence Borough, Westmoreland County, through St. Clair Township as the Veterans Highway.

The Turnpike Commission shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs for the Marine Cpl. Thomas R. Matty Memorial Interchange. PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying the remaining two designations.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge, highway, or intersection costs \$500. The cost to the Turnpike Commission will be approximately \$500 and the cost to PennDOT will be approximately \$1,000 for the 2 designations. All costs can be absorbed within available funding.
