**SUMMARY:** House Bill 471, Printer's Number 516, amends Act 78 of 2008 by repealing state blending, use and reporting requirements related to cellulosic ethanol.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill amends the Biofuel Development and In-State Incentive Act (Act 78 of 2008) to remove all references related to the blending, use and reporting requirements related to cellulosic ethanol in the act. It specifically removes the definition of cellulosic ethanol, the cellulosic ethanol content requirement in gasoline, and the authority and responsibility of the Department of Environmental Protection.

Rescinding the State requirement will not impact or alter federal ethanol blending requirements currently in effect with gasoline sold in the Commonwealth.

This legislation would take effect in 60 days upon enactment.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no impact on Commonwealth funds.
