SUMMARY:

House Bill 585 amends Title 20 (Decedents, Estates, and Fiduciaries) concerning anatomical gifts. It would take effect immediately.

ANALYSIS:

This legislation states that an individual who is in need of an anatomical gift, or organ donation, cannot be deemed ineligible to receive a donation solely because of the individual's physical or mental disability, unless a physician has examined the individual and determined the disability to be medically significant to the provision of the anatomical gift. In addition, if an individual has the necessary support system to assist in complying with post-transplant medical requirements, an individual's inability to independently comply with those requirements cannot be deemed medically significant.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse impact on Commonwealth funds.
