SUMMARY:

House Bill 619, printer's number 689, amends the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L. 90, No. 21), as reenacted and amended, and known as the Liquor Code, to further provide for wine auction permits. The effective date is 60 days after enactment.

ANALYSIS:

The bill amends Section 408.12 of the Liquor Code to broaden the list of entities that may apply for a wine auction permit to include any college or university which is a member of the Association of Independent Colleges and Universities of Pennsylvania. Wine auction permits may be obtained through an application to the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board and a payment of a fee of thirty dollars (\$30) per day for a period of not more than four consecutive or nonconsecutive days per calendar year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The enactment of this legislation will increase revenue to the State Stores Fund by a nominal amount to the extent that the newly eligible colleges and universities apply for wine auction permits.
