**SUMMARY:** House Bill 753, Printer's Number 1052, creates the Pennsylvania Long-term Care Council. This legislation is effective in six months.

**ANALYSIS:** This bill, a freestanding act, repeals Section 212 of the Public Welfare Code which created the Intra-Governmental Council on Long-Term Care and establishes the Pennsylvania Long-term Care Council within the Department of Aging. The bill outlines the membership of the council; term limits; powers and duties; expenses; and establishment of council committees.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Enactment of this legislation will have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds. According to the Department of Aging, any related costs can be absorbed by the Department's General Government Operations appropriation.
