**SUMMARY:** Allows for the de-titling of vehicles which are recycled by a scrap metal processor; and provides a way for an insurance company to apply to PennDOT for a salvage certificate for a vehicle after a total loss. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation makes a certificate of title exempt from the requirements of notarization and verification by a corporate officer when it is transferred from a vehicle owner to a scrap metal processor. The processor is then required to immediately send the title to PennDOT for either a nonrepairable vehicle designation or a certificate of salvage.

The legislation also allows an insurance company to request, from PennDOT, a salvage certificate for a vehicle for which they have paid a settlement on a total loss and have not obtained the title from the vehicle owner.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
