SUMMARY: Amends Title 75 (Vehicle Code) regarding proceeding through inoperable or malfunctioning traffic signals. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation permits vehicles that fail to be detected by automated traffic signals to proceed according to the current process outlined in Section 3112(c) of the Vehicle Code for inoperable or malfunctioning signals.

The legislation also removes the sunset provisions under Sections 3116 and 3117 of the Vehicle Code that allow for automated red light enforcement systems in the City of Philadelphia and certain other municipalities.

FISCAL IMPACT: This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or municipal funds.
