**SUMMARY:** Amends the Board of Vehicles Act to clarify that a licensed salesperson who is employed by a dealer who has an ownership share in more than one dealership, may sell at each of those dealerships regardless of the percentage of ownership. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends the Board of Vehicles Act (Act 84 of 1983) to do the following:

- Defines the term "Common ownership" to mean when a person has an ownership interest in two or more dealerships regardless of the location, the percentage of ownership or the corporate structure of each dealership.
- Amends existing language to ensure that licensed salespersons may sell at multiple dealerships provided there is common ownership.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
