**SUMMARY:** Repeals a 1943 act authorizing the Commonwealth and municipalities to take over public roads and highways constructed by the federal government. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation repeals Act 131 of 1943, which authorized the Department of Highways and counties, cities, boroughs, towns and townships to adopt and take over public roads and highways constructed by the federal government in the exercise of war power.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation would have no adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth or local funds.
