**SUMMARY:** House Bill 1210, Printer's Number 1584 amends the definition of "exploitation" in the Older Adult Protective Services Act. This legislation is effective in 60 days.

**ANALYSIS:** This legislation amends the definition of "exploitation" to specifically include an individual who is acting under a power of attorney. The additional language will clarify that these individuals are subject to the Older Adult Protective Services Act.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This legislation clarifies but does not expand the number of individuals covered under the definition of exploitation; therefore, passage should not have an adverse fiscal impact on Commonwealth funds.
