SUMMARY: Designates a section of Christopher Columbus Boulevard in Philadelphia County as the William J. Guarnere and Edward Babe Heffron Memorial Boulevard. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation designates a section of Christopher Columbus Boulevard, between Oregon Avenue and Washington Avenue, in the city of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County as the William J. Guarnere and Edward Babe Heffron Memorial Boulevard.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. That cost can be absorbed in currently allocated funds.
