SUMMARY: Makes several highway, ramp, and bridge designations. This legislation would take effect in 60 days.

ANALYSIS: This legislation makes several highway, ramp, and bridge designations:

- A section of Christopher Columbus Boulevard, between Oregon Avenue and Washington Avenue, in the city of Philadelphia, Philadelphia County as the William J. Guarnere and Edward Babe Heffron Memorial Boulevard.
- A portion on US Route 222 in Lancaster County as the Senator Noah W. Wenger Highway.
- A bridge on a portion of S.R. 1029 in Wyoming County as the Jody Allen Cron Memorial Bridge.
- Exit 113 from Interstate 79 onto S.R. 208 in Mercer County as the Lieutenant Colonel Michael E. McLaughlin Veterans Ramp.
- A portion of S.R. 88, over Muddy Creek in Greene County as the Army Specialist Richard W. Kowalewski, Jr., Memorial Bridge.

PennDOT shall be responsible for erecting and maintaining appropriate signs displaying this designation to traffic in both directions.

FISCAL IMPACT: According to PennDOT, installation of 2 signs, 1 in each direction, dedicating a bridge or highway costs \$500. For these five designations, the cost would total \$2,250 as the ramp designation would only cost \$250. These costs can be absorbed within currently allocated funds.
